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Professional Registration and Qualification Checks

Introduction

NOA Healthcare has the responsibility to ensure members are appropriate people, suitably qualified, with current statutory and legislative training to be able to satisfactorily and safely carry out their role as independent practitioners without compromising the safety of those to whom they deliver care.

This includes checks with the relevant professional registration bodies such as GMC, HPC and NMC.

Policy

NOA Healthcare will examine documents following recognised procedures and maintain records demonstrating that each member is entitled to practice in the professional capacity for which they have been enrolled as a member.

As an Independent Practitioner, members are professionally responsible to ensure they demonstrate their fitness to practise.

However, where there are costs implications, NOA Healthcare will make payment and claim back a relevant deduction from the member's future earnings.
